Detailed Itinerary

Day 1

We will arrive to Naples and be transported to the hotel accommodation in the Sorrento city center via luxury coach. After check-in, everyone will have a free day, to relax at the hotel, go to the beach or go shopping in the center.

Day 2

We will depart by private bus to Positano. This spectacular, scenic drive hugs the Amalfi coastline before depositing us in the heart of Positano. We will wind our way through town ending at the black sand beaches. Once in Positano, your trip leader will point out locations for sandwiches, snacks, and drinks, in addition to other good places to eat. You will then have the entire day to relax on the beach, swim in the sparkling blue waters, and browse the many shops



of Positano, known for ceramics and lace! It is also possible to rent a boat, kayaks, or stand-up paddle boards while there. Our private bus will take you directly back to our accommodation.

During the evening, we will go to a local eatery for our welcome dinner.

Day 3

In the morning we depart for the port where we board the ferry and set sail for the Island of Capri. Upon arrival, we begin our private island boat tour. First stop is the Blue Grotto. You will be transferred directly from our boat into small row boats that will bring you into the grotto (weather permitting). We will then continue around the island to check out more sights finishing at Marina Grande. We will take private bus transfers up to Capri Town to sip granitas and take photos in front of the amazing backdrop of Capri. Our private transport will then bring us further up to Anacapri, the highest part of the island.. In the early afternoon, we will ride the chairlift to the top of Mt. Solaro to get a breathtaking 360 degree view of the island. We will take private bus transfers down to Capri Town to sip granitas and take photos in front of the amazing backdrop of Capri. After, we will head back down to Marina Grande where you will have free time to spend on the beach or exploring the shops downtown. We will take a ferry back to Sorrento from Marina Grande.

Day 4

We will depart in the morning to leave for Rome and be staying the elegant Prati neighborhood, filled with shopping and small bistros. After Lunch, we will start the day with a guided tour of the Colosseum and the Roman Forum. Afterwards, we will take a walking tour around this beautiful city to see most famous sites: the Spanish Steps, Trevi Fountain, and the Pantheon. Then you are free to further explore Rome, the capital of history's most influential empire.

Day 5

After breakfast, your day is completely free to shop, explore, and relax. Consult with your local trip leader on the different activities, sites, eateries that are available. The group will enjoy a 'Farewell Dinner' of Roman cuisine during their last night in the city.

Day 6

Following breakfast, the group will be transported back to the Rome airport.

Frequently Asked Questions:

Q: How much is entry to the Vatican:

A: A full price ticket to the Vatican is €16. If you wish to enter the Vatican and skip the line, you can pre-book this on the Vatican website and pay a €4 fee to skip the line.

Q: How much is entry to the Roman Pantheon?

A: Entry is free

Q: Can I use a credit card everywhere?

A: It's best to have a small amount of cash, as not every place in Rome and the Amalfi Coast take card.

Q: What are some traditional Roman dishes?

A: Carbonara (pasta made with egg and bacon), Cacio e Pepe (pasta with sheep's cheese and pepper), & Pollo Romana (roast chicken with peppers in red sauce)



Q: What are some traditional dishes in the Amalfi Coast?

A: Caprese salad (invented in Capri), Seafood Pasta, Pizza (invented in the area)

Q: What are some activities to do in Positano?

A: You can rent boats, kayaks, and stand up paddle boards (prices vary per hour). Beach chairs and umbrellas can be rented for €10 (cash only) for the day.

Q: Is there a beach in Capri?

A: Yes, there is a public beach in Marina Grande that you can visit during free time.

Q: How long does it take to go up the chairlift in Capri to Monte Solaro?

A: It takes 15 minutes to ride to the top. Once at the top, you can get off and allow yourself about 20-30 minutes for pictures and to take in the views. It takes 15 minutes more to ride the chairlift to the bottom.

Q: Can I swim in the Blue Grotto?

A: No, it is illegal.

Q: How long is the ride from Rome to the Amalfi Coast?

A: About 3.5 hours.

Q: How long is the ferry ride from Sorrento to Capri?

A: About 45 minutes.

Q: How long is the ride from Sorrento to Positano?

A: About 45-60 minutes.
